

Company energy audit

The Energy Efficiency Law ([Energoefektivitātes likums](#)) states that Large Electricity Consumers should carry out an energy audit or introduce an energy management system (ISO 50001). It must be submitted to the Ministry of Economics by April 1 of the current year and is valid for 4 years.

A large electricity consumer is a company with an annual electricity consumption of over 500 MWh.
